**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 069**  
**Series of 2020**

**"AN ORDER IMPOSING A SCHEDULE FOR THE ENTRY OF SHOPPERS IN THE CARBON PUBLIC MARKET COMPLEX WITHIN THE PERIOD OF THE ENHANCED COMMUNITY QUARANTINE IN CEBU CITY"**

**WHEREAS**, on March 16, 2020, President Rodrigo R. Duterte, recognizing that the COVID-19 public health event constitutes a threat to national security, declared a State of Calamity throughout the Philippines through Proclamation No. 929;

**WHEREAS**, the City Government of Cebu has imposed a State of Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) through Executive Order No. 064 issued on March 26, 2020, which includes a mandatory stay at home order for all individuals;

**WHEREAS**, only one household member is authorized to leave their homes for purposes of accessing basic necessities, as long as they bring their duly issued ECQ Pass;

**WHEREAS**, in order to properly enforce strict social distancing and to limit the number of people going in and out, there is a need to implement a scheduling for the entry and admission of shoppers inside the Carbon Public Market Complex;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDGARDO C. LABELLA**, City Mayor of the City of Cebu, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:

**SECTION 1. SCOPE.** For purposes of this Executive Order, the Carbon Public Market Complex shall include all roads leading to the market buildings, such as Magallanes Street, Escaño Street, Calderon Street, Manalili Street, Plaridel Street, F. Gonzales Street, M.C. Briones Street, and M.L. Quezon Boulevard.

Other private establishments located within the complex such as banks, bakeshops, pharmacies, hardwares and supermarkets shall not be covered by this Order.

**SECTION 2. SCHEDULE.** The schedule of admission of shoppers inside the Carbon Public Market Complex shall be based on the first letter of the family name of the shopper as follows:

The Carbon Public Market Complex shall be open to shoppers from 6 A.M. until 5 P.M. only. During this period, no vehicles shall be allowed entry into the Complex.

The designated delivery schedule of cargoes and supplies shall be from 3 A.M. to 6 A.M. and from 5 P.M. to 8 P.M, during which, trucks and vehicles may be allowed to enter. Authorized wholesalers, purchasers, and kumpradors shall be allowed entry within these schedules.

**SECTION 3. ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENT.** Each shopper who wishes to enter the Carbon Public Market Complex shall be required to present an Identification (ID) Card which should show their photo and complete name. This requirement is on top of existing requirements such as an ECQ Pass and the wearing of face masks, among others. Those who fail to comply with the necessary requirements shall be denied entry and / or shall not be allowed to purchase.

**SECTION 4. CLOSURE.** The Carbon Public Market shall be closed to shoppers every Mondays. This day shall be dedicated for thorough cleansing and disinfecting activities to be done by the Markets Operations Division (MOD) as well as the individual vendors / sellers / concessionaires in their respective stalls or areas.

**SECTION 5. EXEMPTIONS.** The following shall be exempted from the scheduling scheme:

- a. Frontliners, medical personnel, and security personnel, provided that they are able to present proof and proper identification;
- b. Wholesalers, purchasers or kumpradors from community markets and from other local government units (LGU), subject to proper endorsement or certification from the concerned LGU;
- c. Hotels, hospitals, orphanages, government facilities;
- d. Such other establishments or individuals who may be exempted by the City Mayor.

**SECTION 6. ENFORCEMENT.** The Philippine National Police (PNP) and the Markets Operations Division (MOD) are hereby directed to implement the full extent of this Order and in consequence thereto, apprehend and file appropriate legal action against violators.

**SECTION 7. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** Should any provision of this Executive Order be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction as invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions not otherwise adversely affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 8. REPEALING CLAUSE.** Any and all executive orders, issuances, rules and regulations, memoranda of the City of Cebu or any part thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Executive Order are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 9. EFFECTIVITY.** This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon signing hereof and shall remain effective until revoked.
